

## *Montenegrin Elections MNEE Database*

### June 2023 Update (changelog)

#### **Dataset 1**

##### **For 1997 presidential elections:**

- Second round: total number of registered voters is 470.491, not 470.421 (typing error corrected).

##### **For 2003 presidential elections:**

- Total votes cast is 221.497 not 221.479 (typing error corrected).

#### **Dataset 3**

##### **For 1996 local elections:**

- Electorate in Berane is 26159 not 26157 (typing error corrected).

##### **For 2002 local elections:**

- Number of Votes won by DSCG in Plav is 456 and not 121 (typing error corrected).

##### **For 2006 local elections:**

- Added data for LPCG-BS coalition in Bar (1019 votes won, 2 seats won).
- Corrected data for *Srpska lista* in Berane (votes and seats won).
- Corrected data for *Srpska lista* in Kolasin and added data for SNP-NS coalition that was not available before.
- Added data for *Savez komunista Jugoslavije – Komunisti Crne Gore* (Pluzine municipality).

##### **For 2010 local elections:**

- The number of valid votes for each entity and the total number of votes in case of Pljevlja, as reported in *2010 Statistical Yearbook*, do not match. This is not my mistake but appears to be an error in the Statistical Yearbook publication: it is impossible that the coalition that won 50.8% of total votes has 1193 votes, while coalition that won 47.3% of total votes has 10345 votes. I suspected typing error, so based on available data, I calculated that actual number of valid votes won by “BOLJA PLJEVLJA – BOLJA CRNA GORA” as the number we get when we subtract from the total number of valid votes the number of votes won by the other two political entities. Indeed, the number we get in this case is 11138 which is 50.82% of total number of valid votes which is in line with what is reported in column “Number of votes - %” of Statistical Yearbook.

#### **For 2012 local elections:**

- In Herceg Novi, votes won by NSCG-SSR is 494 not 564 (typing error corrected).
- For Budva, the participants of “Evropska Budva” coalition are DPS-SDP.

#### **For 2016 local elections:**

- In Budva, total number of votes won and those won by each party/coalition do not match, but this data is taken as reported in Statistical Yearbook. Same issue for Gusinje, the total number does not match sum of votes won by each party/coaliton. Also for Kotor.
- For Tivat, results for 4 political entities that were not present in the data sheet before are now available.

#### **For 2018 local elections:**

- In Bar, total number of votes won and those won by each party/coalition do not match and given that I took this data from 2020 Statistical Yearbook, I cross-checked with a news report from 14 June 2023 (available at [barinfo.me](http://barinfo.me)) and found out that the number of votes for PRAVA is 662 not 622 as reported in Statistical Yearbook. In the mentioned report I also found data on number of votes cast and valid votes.

### **For 2019 local elections:**

- For Tuzi, total number of votes won and those won by each party/coalition do not match. After cross-check with official results published by [Tuzi Electoral Commission](#), I found that the Total number of valid votes should be 7815, not 6989 as reported in the Statistical Yearbook.

### **For 2020 local elections:**

- For Andrijevica, votes won by coalition of Demokrate and DEMOS is 310 and not 30 (typing error corrected).
- For Tivat, seats won by coalition “Narod pobjedjuje” is 13, not 1 (typing error corrected).

## **Dataset 4**

### **For May 1992 Federal elections:**

- Number of votes won by Djurovic Dragan in Danilovgrad is 5754 not 5716 (updated after cross-check with the Official results published in the Federal Gazzette of FRY).
- Electorate for PR constituency in Montenegro was 349.674 not 353.917 (correction made after cross-check with final results published a day later compared to old source used).
- Added valid votes number for PR constituency which is 338046.
- Corrected name for SKPJ candidate in constituency *II-Cetinje* (typing error).

## **Electoral Maps Booklet**

**Page 8** – *Stranka ravnopravnosti* (Party of Equality) represented Bosniak minority, not Albanian.
