

## Montenegrin Elections (MNEE) Database

### List of Abbreviations and Names of Parties, Coalitions and Group of Citizens

*Last updated: 14 June 2025*

**NOTE:** This document serves to make navigating through the MNEE Database easier by providing a chronological overview of all party and coalition abbreviations that are used in the database with the accompanying English translation and potentially useful additional data. English translation is supposed to make understanding of the official name easier, but it does not necessarily represent the official name of that party/coalition in English as this data is mostly absent and in some cases translating party/coalition and civic movement names would be extremely difficult due to language specificities. Of course, sometimes parties and coalitions participated in different types of elections (national, local, and federal) under the same name, so this needs to be taken into account if searching for the translation of the same abbreviation that might be missing for one type of election but is present for other type of election in this document.
